Principles:

In the Government Order read at (1) above, sanction was accorded to the exemption of Sales Tax on Diesel consumed by the captive generating units without any time limit.

In the Government Order read at (2) above, the re-imbursment of Sales Tax on LSMS and Furnace Oil used for captive power generation is limited to a period of five years. Since the spirit of this order is to limit the concession to a period of five years, provision of the earlier order if continued would result in conflict. further, in the said order the reimbursement of Sales tax on Diesel used in captive power generation has not been included and it required to be included.
